Cobbs Creek Safety Mtg Guidance Questions

- 1. What are the crime & safety issues in and around Cobbs Creek Park and its recreationational facilities?
 - What times of day and what locations are perceived to be the most dangerous for residents wanting to use the park and its trails?
 - What behaviors are people observing that present a danger to public safety?
 - Do people have a sense of individuals or organizations that have been persistently a problem (not asking people to name specific individuals or groups but rather explore the extent to which some problems are well known to the community).
 - Are there others in the community who should be consulted about these issues in order for the Police to have a thorough understanding of what is going on?
 - Has there been a history of solving problems in the park in the past? If so, who was involved and what worked?
- 2. What law enforcement entities (i.e., police departments) have jurisdiction over Cobbs Creek Park and its recreational facilies?
- 3. What civic groups (i.e., town watches, weed & seed, block captains, neighborhood associations) are active in crime & safety issues in and around Cobbs Creek Park and its recreational facilities?
- 4. What organizations & institutions (i.e., Life Center of Eastern Delaware County, Darby-Cobbs Watershed Partnership, houses of worship, etc.) are active in crime & safety issues in and around Cobbs Creek Park and its recreational facilities?
- 5. What law enforcement initiatives have been successful to date in and around Cobbs Creek Park and its recreational facilities?
- 6. What law enforcement initiatives are planned for Cobbs Creek Park and its recreational facilities in this coming year?
- 7. In what ways can civic groups, organizations, and institutions assist law enforcement entities to make Cobbs Creek Park and its recreational facilities more safe?
